**Biographical Note:** Dr. Charles E. Harris was born November 12, 1868, in Waterford, Vermont and passed away at Cape Cod Hospital in Hyannis, Massachusetts on May 26, 1947. Dr. Harris was educated at St. Johnsbury Academy and Springfield, Massachusetts College. He received his medical degree from Baltimore Medical School and came to Hyannis to start his medical practice in 1898. Dr. Harris played an active role in establishing the Cape Cod Hospital in Hyannis. Several years before the new hospital was built he would host circus fundraisers in his back yard where local residents would dress up as animals and clowns to entertain the guests. Once the new hospital was established he then worked on starting an X-ray department and served as its first chief. During World War I he served in the Army medical corps and was stationed in Springfield, Ma. Never one to rest on his laurels, he involved himself with the Federated Church in Hyannis, was a trustee of the Hyannis Public Library, belonged to the Chamber of Commerce and the Rotary Club, and was a founding member of the Hyannis USO during WWII.

In addition to the above accomplishments he also published two book titles: *Hyannis Sea Captains*, *A Vermont Village*, and a pamphlet on Ora Adams Hinckley, the Director of the Hyannis Public Library. Dr Harris was also a covered bridge enthusiast and he traveled New England to photograph them.

**Scope and Content Note:** This collection consists of two series: Personal and Research. The research series contains notes about his publications as well as a photograph collection that documents Hyannis sea captain homes. Dr. Harris's Albums have been placed with the Photo and Image Collection Box 2 MC.18
